## SUBJECT: PROCEDURE FOR ONLINE PERSONAL HEARING.

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that a large number of complaints are pending due to delay in personal hearing and non-availability of complainants belonging from remote areas. The Director General (BE&OE) is pleased to allow Protectors of Emigrants to conduct the online personal hearing to improve the complaint resolution process and ensure quick service delivery.

- 2. If an OEP or a complainant belongs to a remote area, the Director General or Protector of Emigrants may conduct online personal hearing of the parties involved in a dispute/ complaint. The following procedure shall be followed:
  - a) The Network System Engineer in Protectorate of Emigrants or Director (IT) in the Bureau shall make arrangements for such online hearing;
  - Parties shall be informed through written and telephonic communication by the Protector of Emigrants;
  - c) Notice for personal hearings shall not be issued with less than 15 days notice period so that the parties shall be able to defend themselves with supporting documents/ evidence; and
  - d) The Protector of Emigrants shall place the proceedings of the hearing on the record with time and date of the hearing.
- 3. Interviews for the issuance of the license and personal hearing under Section 12 (3) of the Emigration Ordinance 1979 shall also be held by the Director General online in case a candidate or OEP belongs to a far-off area.
- 4. All Protectorates of Emigrants are requested to align their complaint management system with the above-mentioned guidelines and initiate the process of online personal hearing for early resolution of pending complaints.
- 5. This issue with the approval of the Director General.
